KINDNESS AND RESPECT - Kindness and respect help make the world a better place and are essential to building and maintaining healthy relationships. They are conscious choices we make each day. We both work in fields where we often interact with people during some of their most vulnerable moments, when kindness may be harder to come by. These experiences have taught us the importance of offering grace and consideration, knowing we may not understand the challenges others are facing. We will teach our child to treat others with compassion and dignity through everyday actions, using "please" and "thank you," opening doors for others, speaking politely, listening attentively, and respecting the opinions and feelings of those around them. We donate to our local food bank and community center and will involve our child in these efforts as they grow, such as donating toys or gifts to children in need, so they can learn the joy and responsibility of caring for others.

FAMILY - Family is at the heart of our lives. Dallas is the oldest of six children, and Allison is the oldest of three, and we both grew up surrounded by strong support and unconditional love from our immediate and extended families. Staying connected is important to us, and we regularly spend quality time together through visits, group chats, and video calls. Our child will grow up with that same sense of belonging and support. They will be included in family traditions and everyday moments, sleepovers with cousins, camping trips, visits to the zoo and playgrounds, and time spent with aunts and uncles. Learning how to work with others by listening, cooperating, and sharing responsibility is an important skill that helps build strong relationships and achieve common goals. We will teach our child the value of teamwork by helping them learn how to be a supportive team player at home, at school, and in the community. We will encourage participation in group activities such as sports, band, plays, or other school or community programs, based on our child's interests. The cousins love playing together, whether it's tag, hide-and-seek, playing with Barbies, or building with Legos, and they are very excited to welcome a new cousin to join in the fun and build lasting bonds.
